

O R D E R

In compliance of the Notification No. 03 dated 6th January, 2022, issued by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Guwahati and as a preventive measure to contain the spread of third wave of COVID-19, the following measures are taken in the court and premises of Baksa District Judiciary:

1. The learned Judicial Officers shall take up hearing of the cases in virtual/hybrid mode as per his/her convenience.
2. The concerned presiding officer shall fix time slot for taking up the cases in order to avoid over-crowding in the court premises. For this purpose, the concerned officer may specify the time for taking up the urgent matters of the first half. In the cause list, the concerned presiding officer may mention about the time slot so as to enable the concerned litigant/public/advocate well ahead.
3. All the UTPs except the first production and recording of the statement u/s 164 Cr.PC shall be taken up by each court through video conferencing.
4. The evidence of M/O and I/O may be recorded through video conferencing while the evidence of other material witnesses may be taken in the virtual mode from a remote point of each court.
5. Cases, if any, pending against MPs/MLAs may be taken up only through video conferencing as far as practicable.
6. Entry in the court premises shall be restricted. Only lawyers/litigants whose presence is necessary and the court staff shall be permitted to enter court premises on production of final COVID vaccination certificate.
7. Non vaccinated/partially vaccinated lawyers/litigants/court staff shall be permitted to enter the court premises only after production of negative RTPCR test report not older than 48 hours.

8. Those litigant public/witnesses who have taken both the doses of COVID vaccine shall have to undergo RAT test at the entrance gate of the court and only those having negative report shall be allowed to enter into the court premise.

9. Wearing of face mask and maintaining social distance shall be mandatory for all concern.

10. Only those advocates and the witnesses whose presence is necessary shall be allowed to enter into the court room as and when the case is called for hearing.

11. The Sheristadar shall ensure the maintenance of a register at the entry point of the court building with recording of name, address and phone number of the outsider thereon. Thermal scanner at the entry point shall also be used to record the temperature of all concern entering into the court building.

12. Advocates, litigant publics, witnesses, court staff shall enter into the court building complying the above directions only through one entry gate and will exit through the main gate.

A copy of this order be communicated to President/Secretary of Baksa District Bar Association, Baksa.

A copy of this order shall also be furnished to learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baksa for information and compliance. Ld. CJM, Baksa is directed to circulate the copies of this order amongst the officer under her establishment.

System Assistant, Baksa is directed to upload the order in the official website of the District Judiciary.

This notification comes into effect from today i.e., **7th January, 2022** and may be varied subject to the direction of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court that may be communicated in due course.
