In pursuance of the Notification No. 61, dated 9th July, 2021 the Courts of the Baksa District Judiciary will resume Limited Court Functioning w.e.f. 12th July, 2021. The following category of cases will be taken up:-

- Hearing of Bail Application u/s 438/439 of Cr.P.C.
- Criminal Revision/Criminal Appeals
- Recording of evidence in cases where sitting/former MPs/MLAs are accused persons.
- Recording of statement of accused person u/s 313 of Cr.P.C. by invoking sub-section (5) of Section 313 Cr.P.C.
- Recording of evidence of M.O./I.O./Judicial Magistrates through video conferencing.
- Succession matters.
- Civil Appeals
- Submission of Examination-in-Chief on affidavit.
- Cross examination of witnesses before Advocate Commissioner by maintaining Covid-19 protocols.
- Injunction matters.
- Arbitration matters
- Arguments

Civil Judge/Munsiff

- The Appeals/Misc. Appeals.
- Miscellaneous Application filed under various provisions of Code of Civil Procedure
- Injunction Matters
- Execution Matters where urgent stay is required
- Submission of examination-in-chief on affidavits
- Cases at the stage of arguments

Further, entry of outsiders is strictly prohibited in the Court premises unless specifically directed by the concerned authority or unless personal appearance of a party is required in Judicial proceeding. No person, except the learned Advocates/parties appearing in person, who are to address arguments, shall be permitted in the Court rooms.

Judicial Officers are hereby directed to prepare cause list for taking up the matters as per the aforesaid Notification of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court and make arrangement to upload the same in the official website.

The office timings will be in accordance with the S.O.P.s issued by the Govt. of Assam from time to time.

Due to shortage of staff, all the staff of this establishment will have to attend office regularly irrespective of vaccinated with single or double dose.

The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Baksa is hereby directed to make arrangement in accordance with the Notification mentioned above for her establishment and to issue a direction to the learned Judicial Officers under her control to prepare special cause list. She is also directed to ensure the presence of sufficient staff for smooth functioning of the Court and Office works of her establishment.
